On Saturday, November 16th, 2019, the University will hold the English Proficiency Test (TOEFL ITP) for First-year Master Students.

- 1 Acceptable forms of identification include:
- . (1) R.O.C. citizens
 - Test takers of 16 years and above: R.O.C. identity card or valid passport. Copies are not accepted.
 - (2) Foreign nationals (non-native English speakers only, including Hong Kong and Macau residents): Valid passport or ARC with passport number. Copies are not accepted.
 - (3) PRC residents:
 - A. "Exit & Entry Permit for the Taiwan Area of the Republic of China" in the original, displaying the holder's identity card number and immigration stamp.
 - B. "往來臺灣通行證" in the original as well as PRC resident identity card in the original.
 - (4) If you fail to bring an acceptable form of identification, you will be given temporary access to the test under the following conditions:

A. You may be given temporary access to the test if you can present a temporary form of identification. A family member or friend must bring your acceptable form of identification (R.O.C. identity card or valid passport only) to the test site before the end of the test. If your identity can be unmistakably established in this way, you are considered to have entered the test with acceptable ID according to regulations. If this is not the case, your test will not be scored. The test fee will not be refunded, nor can the test be rescheduled.

- B.Temporary acceptable ID must be in card format and include all of the following: photo, name, R.O.C. identity card number, date of birth.
- 2 On the day of the test, please ensure that you bring with you an acceptable form of . identification, medium-soft pencils (2B), and erasers.
- 3 The test will take place on Saturday, November 16, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- . The test site will be open for entrance from 09:40 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Starting from 10:00 a.m., test takers will not be allowed to enter the test site.
